Rabindranath Tagore International Institute of Cardiac Sciences (RTIICS), also popularly known as RN Tagore Hospital, Kolkata, is a 681-bedded, JCI and NABH-accredited multi-superspeciality quaternary care hospital, established in the year 2000. RTIICS has 15 fully-equipped operation theatres and 4 state-of-the-art catheterisation laboratories with 24-hour facility.

It provides services to the people of West Bengal and the neighbouring states in Eastern India and North Eastern India. RTIICS is a global health-care hub catering to patients from countries such as Bangladesh, Bhutan, Myanmar, Nepal as well as African countries.

RTIICS is a centre of excellence in Cardiac Sciences and Heart Transplantation, Renal Sciences and Kidney Transplantation, Neurosciences, Medical & Surgical Gastroenterology, Hepatobiliary Sciences and Liver Transplantation and Medical and Surgical Cancer services. The hospital offers services in over 40 clinical specialities for acute and chronic ailments.

RTIICS was adjudged the 'No. 1 Cardiac Care Hospital' in Eastern India, by the Times of India Health Survey 2016, 2017 and 2018. RURAL HEALTH CARE FOUNDATION

At Rural Health Care Foundation (RHCF), has been committed to empowering the rural communities of West Bengal with high-quality and low-cost medical care. In 15 years they have treated over 36 lakh underprivileged patients through well-equipped primary care centres that have general, eye, dental and homeopathy departments and pharmacies.

At present, they have 12 units across 7 districts, and are in the process of setting up their 13th unit. they are currently making quality primary care accessible to 1200+ villages. Communities have easy access to low-cost doctor's consultation and 1-week's supply of free medications, along with low-cost spectacles and, in collaboration with Rotary, to free cataract surgeries.

Since June 2022, they have adopted a holistic approach to care. While the healthcare centres focus on ensuring curative care, their preventive care programme, with door-to-door screenings in rural households, aims for early detection of lifestyle diseases, eye problems, dental problems and skin issues. Till date, they have screened over 4.8 lakh beneficiaries.

During FY 2023-24, they have operated 12 rural primary healthcare centres:

Their outreach screenings for preventive care were conducted within 10-15 km radius of each of the rural centres. They also operated 3 urban centres in Chowringhee, Regent Park and Zakaria Street for the urban underserved.

SAROJ GUPTA CANCER CENTRE AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE

The very word Cancer throws a scare in your mind, pronounces the ultimatum, writes an epitaph. Unless you have first hand experience or you watched a near and dear one struggle, you actually have no idea what desperation Cancer can cause. You pray, you curse, you bargain with God, you clutch at any hope for a second chance at life. It is the second leading cause of death all over the world, of which tobacco itself accounts for 30% of all cancers. The good news is awareness reduces death by 50% and it can be cured if detected at an early stage.

In early 1973, seeing the plight of cancer patients who failed to get even a bed, not to talk about cancer care, Dr Saroj Gupta, then a young Radiotherapist, formed a Society with a group of Doctors, social workers and philanthropists. His mission was to form a Cancer Centre for the cancer afflicted patients and their families, with special emphasis on the underprivileged people. At Thakurpukur, on a piece of marshy land donated by the family of Late Chintaharan Das, SAROJ GUPTA CANCER CENTRE & RESEARCH INSTITUTE was incepted initially to provide a sojourn to the distressed cancer patients who came from remote villages for treatment of cancer. No one ever thought that this little known Thakurpukur would be an internationally known place.

The first fund-raising event was a drama staged by a group called Sikha, based on a story written by Dr Saroj Gupta, where he himself enacted the role of a poor cancer patient who was denied a bed in the city hospital. Tears rolled down the cheeks of all those who were present there by the touching fact that there was no place for a little body of him in a big city with tall buildings and big hospitals, although he had traveled all the way from a remote village with a strong desire to live. Many in the audience became a part of the Society and joined hands with Dr Gupta to help him with his fight against Cancer.

Over a period of 3 decades, with unimaginable help from all walks of life starting from poorest of the poor and school children to different Industrialists and celebrities, the hospital now has become a fully comprehensive, 311 bedded dedicated cancer hospital, now re-named as SAROJ GUPTA CANCER CENTRE & RESEARCH INSTITUTE.

Set in a wonderful ambience spread on sprawling 16 acres of land with lush green lawns, water bodies, hillocks, Amusement park, Toy train, patients get the vital dose of energy and solace in between toxic chemotherapies or painful surgeries. The institute has kept pace with science and technology, and continuous upgradations have been done. Thus the latest Diagnostic facilities and Radiotherapy machines, Surgical gadgets for all kinds of complicated surgeries are now available in specially designed Units. All these facilities are available at prices affordable to all classes of people. In the enchanting yet formidable expanse of the Sundarbans, the pursuit of quality education seemed like an unattainable dream. Swapnopuron, however, defied the odds and turned the impossible into reality. Swapnopuron emerged as a transformative force, unlocking the doors to education in areas where such opportunities were once scarce.

From its modest beginnings with just 25 students in 2012, Swapnopuron has blossomed into an institution with over 850 active students and 42 dedicated teachers by 2024. Our three branches, Ganesh Mondal, Choto, and Kalitala, are strategically situated on the remote islands of Sundarbans, ranging from Nursery to Class VI. The organization has successfully engaged over 800 beneficiaries through skill development activities such as tailoring, soap and candle making, bag making, and various others. Additionally, through targeted programs like SAG-KP, Mental Health, and Door-to-Door Counseling, we have reached and positively impacted more than 10,000 students.

Our mission has always been to bring light into the lives of children through education. However, to secure CBSE affiliation and ensure a seamless educational journey for our students, we need to complete our school building according to CBSE requirements.

MUKTI is a non-profit socio-economic organization that has been working in South 24 Parganas, East Medinipur, West Medinipur, Howrah and in other parts of West Bengal.

The organization is registered as a Trust with a **vision to Engage largest number of volunteers to create grassroot level socio economic development organization that contributes towards sustainable development of people in need.** MUKTI's mission is to work as a HEALER- AID for our society in the area of Health (Health, Water & Sanitation), **Education (Education & Empowerment)**, Agriculture (Agricultural Reforms), Livelihood (Livelihood & Sustainability), Environment, Recovery & Resiliency, Integrated Development and Disaster Relief, irrespective of caste, creed, age and gender.

The organization has **positively impacted over 10 lakh beneficiaries, covering about 1.5 lakh households, including 30,000 SHG women and 7000+ children, irrespective of caste, creed, age, and gender** with an objective to uplift the grassroots who are in penury, social exclusion and myriad discrimination and are extremely vulnerable to climate hazards like strong storms, cyclic cyclone and frequent dreadful disasters adding to resource dearth, penury, vulnerability, and violence.

The organization has a UN Special Consultative Status and is supported by more than 120+ enterprises from all over the world. Mukti became the 1st organization in West Bengal and 3rd in India to be listed under NSE-Social Stock Exchange.

SRIJAN'S SUPPORT With Srijan's support they are operating 6 MSS at Krishnachandrapur 1, Krishnachandrapur 2, Gilerchhat, Akshaynagar, Dakshin Kashinagar and Fatikpur. A total of 420 students are being supported along with 30 MSS teachers through Srijan's donations towards the cause.

DHYAN FOUNDATION is a Charitable Organisation working consistently & dedicatedly for the rescue & rehabilitation of cow and its progeny. Dhyan Foundation Trust regd with Doc no 2235, Addl Book No 4 on 27/05/2002, AWBI Regn ND054/2019.

We have over 50 thousand plus 'gouvansh' rehabilitated in 47 'gaushalas' and animal shelters across India.

We are rehabilitating all the cattle in our 'gaushalas', rescued by BSF from being smuggled at Indo-Bangladesh border for illegal slaughter.

SRIJAN'S SUPPORT Supported to towards rehabilitation and protection of rescued cattle which in turns shall be instrumental in maintaining the ecological balance.

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EKTARA

EKTARA facilitates education and empowerment of 1300 girls and women through our various programmes at our 30,000 sqft facility. EKTARA started in 2011 with 30 children. EKTARA works with families of marginalised migrant unskilled labourers who moved to Kolkata looking for employment opportunities and are predominantly employed as daily wagers. They run programmes on Education from pre-primary till college, child welfare, health, hygiene, meals and vocational training. They work extensively with girls from marginalized communities with limited access to school environments. The EKTARA Learning Centre works with its students to not just cope academically, but also meet their social emotional needs. The EKTARA Learning Centre is fully equipped with music, dance, drama, art and digital literacy learning opportunities in addition to full academic support in classrooms, health hygiene monitoring, nutritious snacks and meals for all children.

Over the last decade, they have not just established ourselves as a sustainable organisation, but also a credible one that is able to offer its expertise at scale. In keeping with their commitment to delivering high quality education for girls, they have made some substantial progress such as • Launched “Anando Gari” a Mobile School project in partnership with the Government of West Bengal to implement projects in 4 KMC schools. • Developed “Model School” with KMCP that includes infrastructure, digital literacy and academic intervention on foundational numeracy and english. • Enrolment of over 250 kids at primary and secondary level in schools such as Simon Day Academy, Joseph Day School, Shree Jain Swetambar Terapanthi Vidyalay, Park English School and the like. This is in addition to the Children in our Ek Tara Learning Centre. • Establishment of EKTARA resource Centre that targets at developing publications for children on various thematic issues that are often not covered in school curriculum. In the current academic year, EKTARA distributed a publication on Climate Change among over 80,000 children across 10 states in the country. The previous publication on COVID was distributed among 40,000 children also reached the parliament and was appreciated by the Hon'ble Vice President of India, Sri M Venkaiah Naidu.

SRIJAN'S SUPPORT Meals programme that provides 1622 cooked meals and snacks to children on a daily basis, totalling up to over 3,89,280 cooked meals in a year. Under this project, the NGO has employed mothers from the community to prepare and distribute nutritious meals to children engaged at EKTARA Learning Centre . A team of 7 women work from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm daily in the EKTARA Community Kitchen.

Their participation not just empowers the women financially , but also ensures children have access to hygienic nutritious meals. Each child at EKTARA is given a snack or a meal depending upon the amount of time spent. over 600 children spend more that 6 hours and are given both a meal and snack.

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SRIJAN'S SUPPORT The initiative aims to provide the resilient people of the Sundarbans with access to affordable housing that can withstand cyclones and floods. The prototype houses,engineered to endure 150km/hr cyclones and 15 feet of water, offer a vital lifeline inthis vulnerable region. There has been a total of 12 completed houses and 7 ongoing houses.

With the assistance of Srijan Realty Pvt Ltd, they have successfully provided support to eight families by supplying fishing boats and nets.

PAWS IN HOPE

PAWS IN HOPE started its journey as HOPE, in November 2016.

A group of ardent dog lovers, cutting across breeds, joined hands to raise fifty thousand rupees, to send two Indie dogs, both eight month old sisters, Mona and Lisa, to their forever home in Meghalaya.

They were born in a posh residential complex in Calcutta, got adopted and then discarded, and being unable to fend for themselves, were starving and living in fear outside the gate, at the mercy of traffic and territorial dogs.

A Facebook plea to help these two pups, swung them into action, and the universe was kind. They raised the money, and after vet checks, vaccinations, organising supplies for the journey payment for two attendants, Rajdhani 1st class coupe ticket etc. The pups were on their way to the most amazing home. As a group they didn't want to disband. They wanted to hope further for these voiceless beings. So they decided to continue, with the purpose of raising funds for sterilisation of community dogs and cats, to reduce their numbers, and thus minimise people animal conflict. Sponsoring treatment too was the next purpose, as was trying to help in rehoming abandoned pets. This is when HOPE became PAWS IN HOPE.

Sterilisation is the ONLY humane way to minimise numbers. They vehemently object to mass culling, poisoning, beating to death, relocating of homeless animals. In fact these are all against the established law of the land. They also try and raise awareness on the need for compassion and understanding and acceptance that every being has a right to life.

From January 2017 to June 2024, they have sponsored the spay neuter of 5000 dogs and cats, treatment of 1500 dogs and cats, and rehomed around 70 odd dogs and cats. Money for this work comes from their own contributions as well as a very committed sponsor. They work with different animal ngos in the city, all trusted, since they do not have their own hospital.

They also have a small shelter at Pailan for 15 dogs and 8 cats. These are animals who will no longer survive on the streets. They are now looking at the possibility of providing on-the-spot street treatment for dogs and cats that do not have to be hospitalised, but need medical attention.
